



**SECOND AMENDMENT TO RULES AND REGULATIONS
FOR
FIRELIGHT MEADOWS CONDOMINIUMS**

The First Amendment to Rules and Regulations for Firelight Meadows Condominiums, recorded January 19, 2005, is hereby amended to add the following Rule:

ITEM 6. In the event of a lease of a unit to third parties, the number of persons allowed in a single leased unit in the Apartments located in Buildings A, B, C and D of Firelight Meadows Condominiums is limited to four persons (4). The owner of a leased unit shall be responsible to the Association for monitoring the leased unit to insure that not more than four (4) persons reside in the unit. However, the Association may enforce the rule in the event the owner fails to do so and may charge the owner for the costs and attorney fees to enforce the rule.

All other Rules and Regulations set forth in Exhibit E to the Declaration and Bylaws of Firelight Meadows Condominium shall remain in full force and effect.

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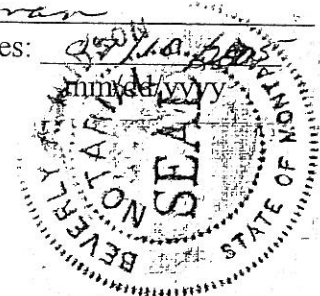
