## Need to file a grievance? Here's how:

Any unit owner who wishes to grieve an action taken to enforce the rules and regulations must do the following:

- Submit a written protest to the president of the association describing the issue and why he or she feels that the action or decision taken should be changed.
- The written protest will then be reviewed by a panel consisting of:
  - I. The president or his or her designee
  - II. The property manager of the association
  - III. The unit owner

IV. A second unit owner chosen by the grieving unit owner to assist in the presentation and review of the written protest

V. One neutral person appointed by the president or his or her designee

The recommendation of this panel will be presented to the entire Board of Directors for action
