Make your Garbage Bear Proof

Do your part to help keep Firelight Meadows safe and free from bears. With the warmer weather waking up hungry bears, we don't want your garbage to entice them down the mountain for an easy snack in your driveway.

Allied Waste now offers Bear Proof residential Trash containers. They cost an additional \$11.20 per month or \$33.60 per quarter due to the additional labor involved in unlocking each one prior to emptying them. Owners that are interested in renting a bear proof container may contact *Allied Waste at 406-586-0606*.

With the help of Hammond Property
Management, your Board of Directors is
determined to keep the bears away from
harming you, your family, your pets or
themselves. The board has made changes to
the Garbage rules under Common Elements
Rule 2010.1. Help us help you by following the
rules for when to put your garbage container
outside.

Common Elements Rule 2010.1

TRASH

- 1. Villa/Chalet owners rely on individual trash pickup service through Allied Waste. As of this writing, pickup service is Monday morning.
- 2. All refuse containers are to be stored inside. On pick up day containers can be put out after 6 AM and must be returned to the garage on the same day. We must follow these rules year round and be extremely vigilant during active bear season.

NOTE: During bear season units with refuse containers outside at times other than listed here will be fined \$800 with no additional warning.

3. Condo units are served with dumpsters located at each building. All trash and unwanted items need to be placed inside the dumpster. The collection service will not collect items outside the dumpster.

The trash portion of the common elements rule 2010.1 is listed in the box on the right side of this page. The full list of rules can be found on the FLM Website.

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Dryer Vent Cleaning

All dryer vents will be cleaned and inspected over the course of the spring and fall offseasons. After this year they will be cleaned and inspected once every two years.

All dryers will also be inspected to insure that they are of the correct capacity. The Bylaws state that all dryers must be at least a 5.7 cubic foot extra-large capacity dryer. It must be powerful enough to push the air through the long air vents. This has been the regulation since the units were built and are necessary to prevent fire damages in the 50 plus foot long ventilation pipes.

We advise checking your dryer to make sure that it meets these requirements to prevent receiving a fine or worse, causing a fire in your unit.

Potential Crosswalks

Board Member Kari Gras has been researching the installation of crosswalks from the Firelight Meadows complex across Ousel Falls Road. Morrison & Maierle (M&M) out of Bozeman is helping her to research the best location for a crosswalk. Part of the cost will likely be covered through the Rural Improvement District (RID) that Firelight currently pays into.
