Campus Snow Removal

During the winter months it is absolutely crucial that your vehicle is cleared of snow & moved after every snow event to allow for adequate snow removal operations. Failure to move your vehicle every 72 hours, OR at the request of Management, will result in your vehicle being towed off the property without warning and at the Owner's expense. Please be mindful of other year-round parking and rule expectations as well.

Friendly Reminders:

- Please winterize exterior hose bibs if you have not done so already. HPM is available to assist with any that are not already off.
- Unplug cords while not in use. A suggestion to be mindful of the charging accessories you use for your electronics and the potential safety hazards that inexpensive charging cords can pose.



- 3. We recommend **replacing smoke detectors batteries** if yours are 10+ years old.
- It's a good idea to periodically check the pipe fittings under your sink for any sign that they are leaking and creating potential for water damage.



Compactor & Carboard Recycling

The compactor is for **household trash only**. With the holidays quickly approaching DO NOT use the compactor for boxes, recycling, or construction/remodel material, furniture, etc. All cardboard **must be broken down** before put into the receptacle to ensure that it can be used to its full potential by all Firelight residents.
