# **Meeting Minutes**

#### Call to Order

Karla called the meeting to order at 6:02 pm.

#### **Attendance**

Board member in attendance included Karla Y., Carol P., Hannah D., Curt W., Julie B., and Jim D. Other present included the new attorney for Firelight Meadows, Margot Ogburn, as well as Mike Palmer, Dan Lukas, Katie Coleman, and Seanna Farrow of Hammond Property Management (HPM).

# **Approval of Meeting Minutes**

Carol motioned to approve the June meeting minutes; Hannah seconded her motion. All were in favor and the minutes were approved as presented.

## **Next Board Meeting**

The next board meeting was scheduled for Tuesday, August 10, 2021.

# **Invasive Species Discussion**

Karla did a walk-around of the campus with Jen from Gallatin Invasive Species Alliance. The invasive weeds on the campus were minimal, and many areas had native grass. Jen plans to send Karla a report with some suggestions including plans and drawings of what native plants can be incorporated into the landscaping aside from native grass.

# **HOA Legal Representative**

Margot Ogburn joined the meeting to introduce herself to the Firelight board members. She has reviewed the current CC&R's of Firelight Meadows HOA and is working on acquainting herself with the HOA's history and current legal needs. She asked the board to designate a board member as a point contact for communicating with her as she has found this to be the most efficient approach.

## **Landscaping Cost-Share Application**

motioned to approve the application as presented at this meeting; Curt and Julie seconded the motion, and all were in favor. Karla and Seanna will work on creating a separate program for owners that are interested in much smaller landscaping projects with a different cost range.

# **HVAC System Update**

Julie continues to do some research on options for air conditioning for board review. She would like to push this item to the next meeting when she hopes to have more information.

#### **Landscaping RFP**

HPM requested the board decide on whether to send the landscaping request for proposal out to bid by August 2021 for the HOA's 2022 landscaping contract.

# **Exterior Lighting Project**

All the exterior lights have been ordered. The first shipment will include 100 light fixtures, and the remainder of the lights are estimated to arrive in 4-6 months. The first phase of installing lights will be funded by the reserve account, and the second phase of installing lights will be budgeted for in 2022. The cost for the chalet lights will be \$255.68 per unit (2 fixtures) and for the condos \$127.84 per unit (1 fixture).

#### **Property Management Report**

# **Paving Project**

Mike has been communicating with Big Sky Asphalt to schedule the remainder of the paving work and does not have an exact date to share at present.

#### <u>Irrigation System</u>

HPM continues to facilitate repairs to the irrigation system. Doug with Gallatin Waterworks is working with HPM on cost estimates for repairing and replacing certain sections of the irrigation system in the coming spring seasons. It will be a combination of eliminating sections and adding others.

# **Street Signs**

Mike continues to communicate with Beartooth Signs regarding new street signs and stop signs for the campus. He will share estimates with the board as soon as possible.

On a separate note, Carol pointed out that there are many windows throughout the complex with damaged screens. Per the rules and regulations, these owners should be notified and fined as needed. HPM will put together a plan for communicating with the units that have screens in need of repair or replacement.

# **Compactor Service Agreement**

Firelight Meadows currently has a contact with Solid Waste Solutions (SWS) located in Idaho. Since working with a local company, Montana Waste and Recycling, in conjunction with Republic Services for the compactor's repair and servicing needs, the board would like to discontinue services with SWS as soon as possible.

Hey Seanna, I get it. I've worked as a PM before. My concern is that this rule for guest passes and its fine assessment scale doesn't fit short term rentals. It may be time to look at when it was adopted and whether it's time to change as our needs change.

I definitely share the rules with my renters and step-up dating efforts. But I hate passing on a \$100 to \$500 parking fine when they are here for 4 days with one out-of-state-plate rental car, in a visitor spot with a visible pass, but missing the dates. Seems like we're getting caught up in a dragnet for real offenders, like those who poach our lot for Rodeo and ski weekends when free-skier is full: That is trespassing; my guests - by definition - are not. I also bet few short-term condo units ever have more than one to two cars out front. So, I can see where a better system might take into account these differences.

**Subject:** Hot Air Balloon Landings

Dear Firelight Board of Directors,

You may or may not be aware that over the last 5 weeks, on three separate occasions, The Hot Air Balloon(s) (Endeavor Balloon Company?) has landed on Firelight Meadow Property. The date of the landings was June 11, July 7 and most recently July 18. The landings take place in the early morning hours between 7:00-8:00 AM. Please see the attached photos. This very disruptive activity is especially concerning to several residents of the South Fork Community, and likely some of your own residents.

The balloon(s) fly at very low altitude over our neighborhood as it approaches the landing site, encroaching on everyone's privacy as the basket is filled with tourists, who have a view inside our homes, and over our backyards and hot tubs. The noise generated by the balloon's burner is deafening and comparable to a jet engine, and the navigational unpredictability of the balloon raises a safety issue for everyone.

The landing itself can be jarring and abrupt. The occupants then negotiate exiting the tall, sided basket and celebrate with champagne. The recovery crew of about four employees traverse your property and load the basket and balloon into a trailer. All these activities together present a great liability to the property owner.

These activities negatively affect the residents of all neighboring homes and the peacefulness and privacy we all seek.

If the Association has given permission for these activities to take place on Firelight property, we respectfully request that you reconsider allowing the Balloon Operator to land on your property, and if you have not, we would hope you would reach out to the Balloon Company and express your opposition.

Please let us know if our Association can assist in this matter. Thank you for your consideration.
